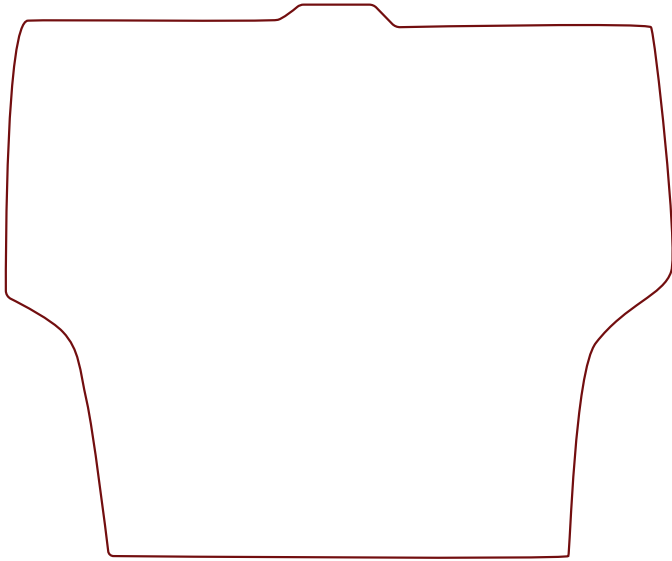

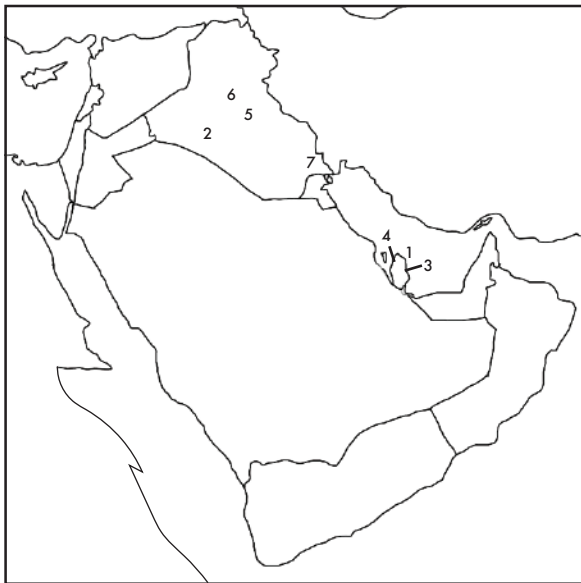

MURWAB : Abbasid city in Qatar

Did you know ...

- Murwab is a city near al-Zubara fort
- It was first excavated in 1959 by a Danish archaeological team and again investigated by a French team in 1979 and a Qatari-French team in 2005
- It is a large settlement with over 200 buildings, more than 45 houses, 2 mosques, a fort, wells and natural water access points
