


WELCOME TO THE QATAR OLYMPIC SPORTS MUSEUM FAMILY TRAILS MOTORSPORTS

The museum features several amazing exhibits, athletes and objects from the motorsports world, such as Formula 1 Grand Prix, rally driving, powerboat racing, MotoGP and speedcars.

Motor racing has always been popular in Qatar, which has hosted many international events, including the FIM Road Racing Championships, the GP2 Asia Series, and now Formula 1. Top rally drivers have been coming to race in the country since the 1970s, the country has hosted the Middle East Rally Championships and boasts one of the all-time greats in rally driving, Nasser Al Attiyah. MOTORSPORTS FACTS

- The same kind of Norton motorbike seen in the museum won the first Isle of Man Tourist Trophy race, in England in 1907,
- German Formula One driver Michael Schumacher notched up an almost unimaginable 91 Grand Prix victories and seven
- Ayrton Senna won 41 Formula One Grand Prix, was world champion three times, and set the fastest qualifying time in 65
