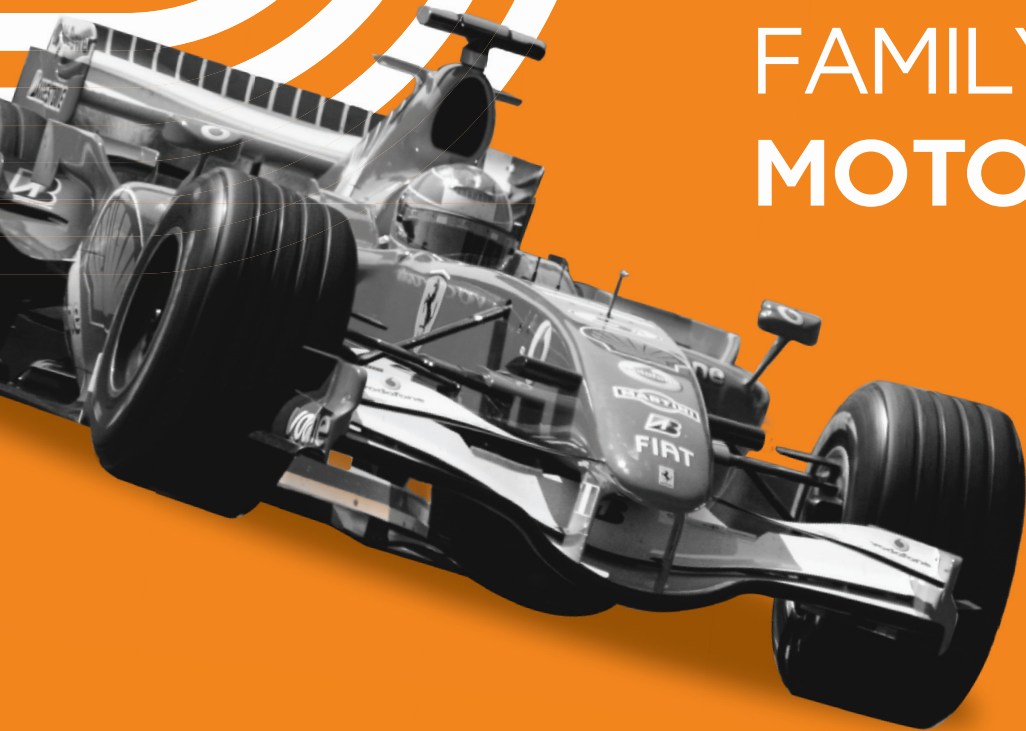

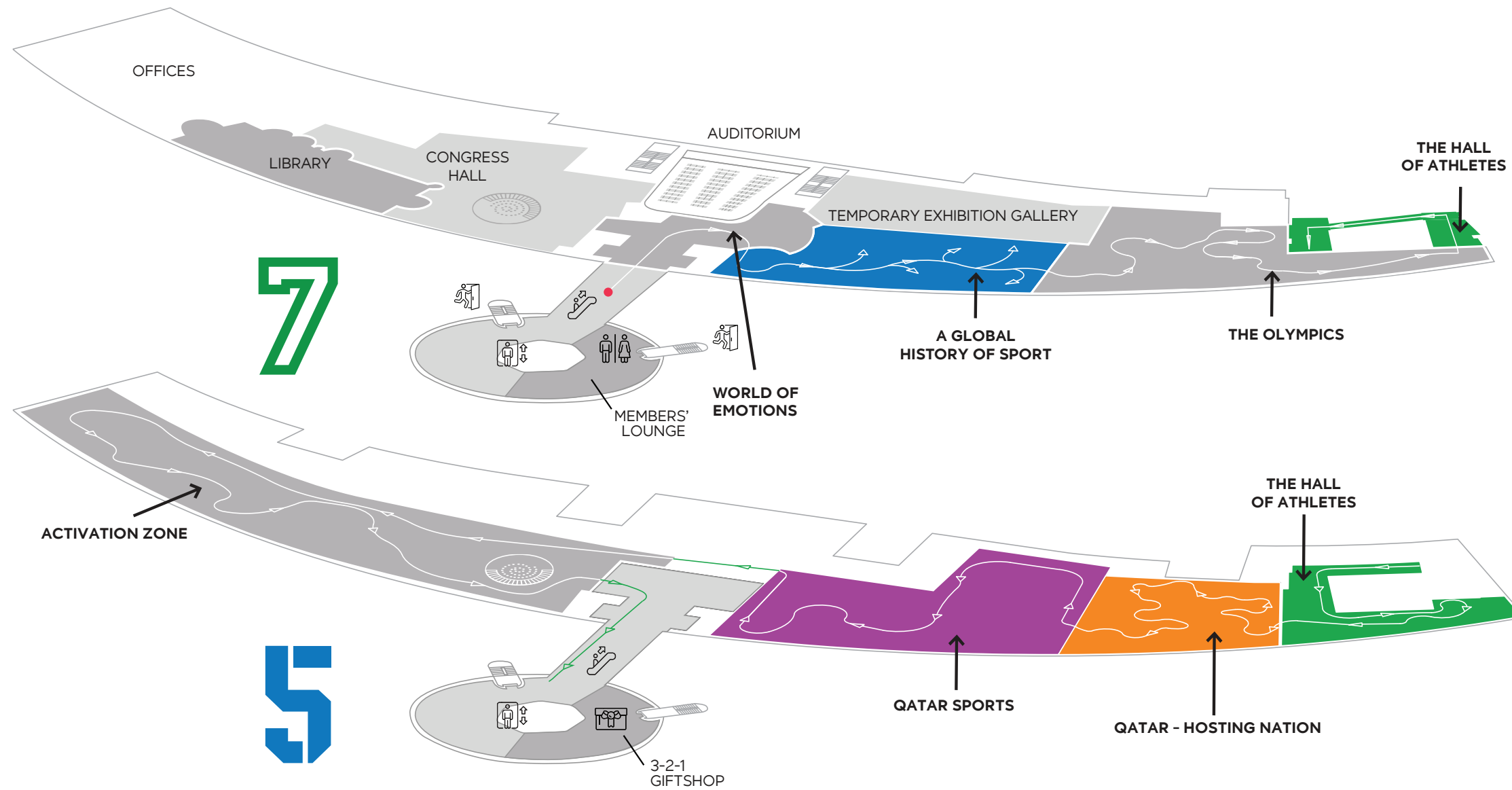

Welcome to the Qatar Olympic and Sports Museum Motorsports Family Trail. Do you like fast cars, bikes and boats? Or the thrill of watching racing motorsports? Well, then start your engines, as you have come to the right place! The museum features several amazing exhibits, athletes and objects from the motorsports world, such as Formula 1 Grand Prix, rally driving, powerboat racing, MotoGP and speedcars.

Motor racing has always been popular in Qatar, which has hosted many international events, including the FIM Road Racing Championships, the GP2 Asia Series, and now Formula 1. Top rally drivers have been coming to race in the country since the 1970s, the country has hosted the Middle East Rally Championships and boasts one of the all-time greats in rally driving, Nasser Al Attiyah. There is something for every motorsports lover on this trail, so get out there and see what other amazing motor racing exhibits you can find!

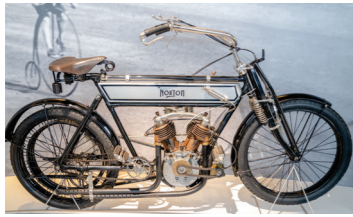

-  Michael Schumacher (Germany) - Formula 1 Grand Prix racing
-  Ayrton Senna (Brazil) - Formula 1 Grand Prix racing
-  Nasser Al Attiyah (Qatar) - Rally driving
-  Sheikh Hassan bin Jabor Al Thani (Qatar) - Powerboat racing
-  Giacomo Agostini (Italy) - Motorcycle GP racing
-  Pat Moss (United Kingdom) - Women's rally driving
-  Ashley Fiolek (United States) - Women's motocross racing

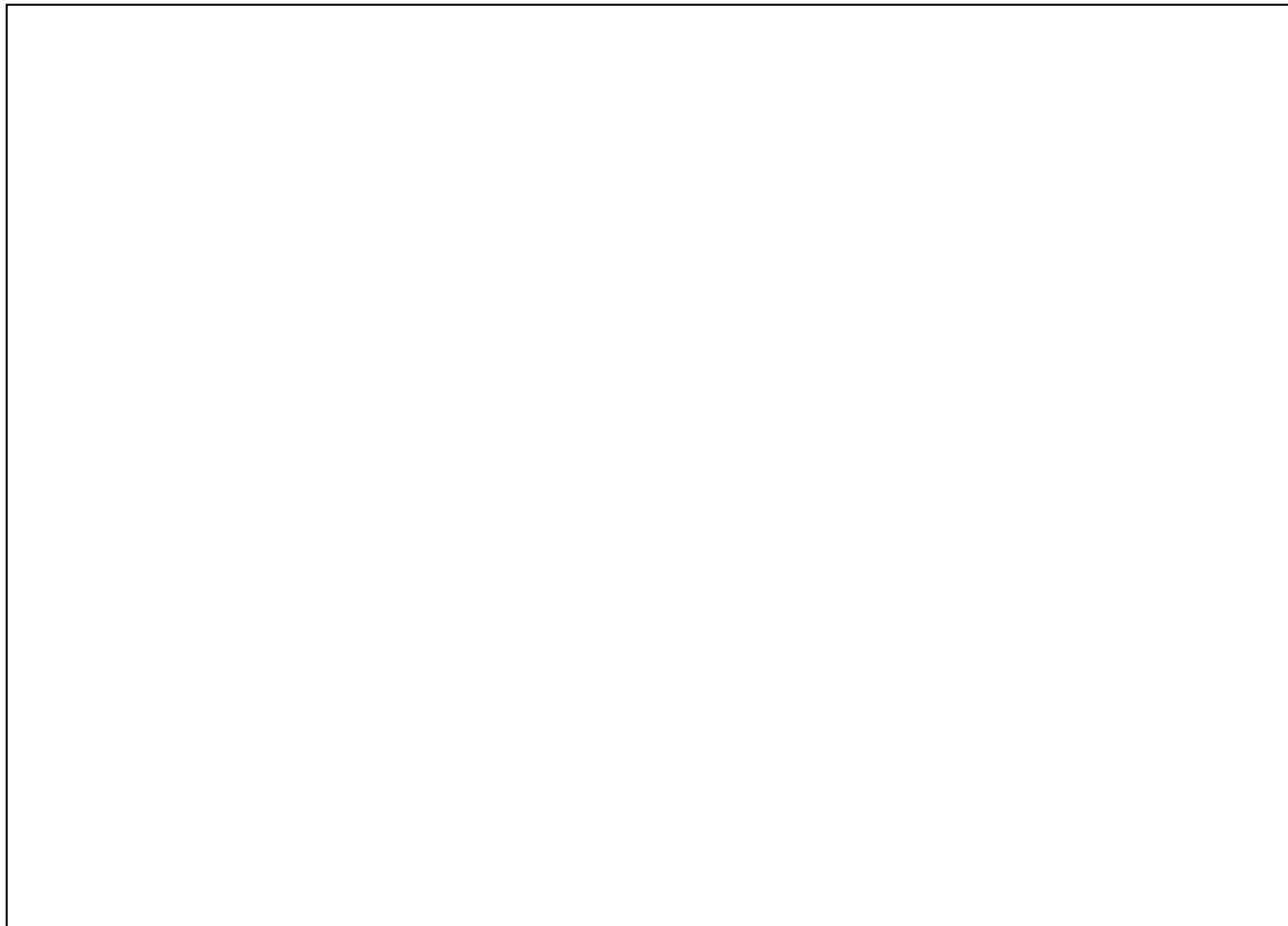
# MOTORSPORTS FACTS

-  The same kind of Norton motorbike seen in the museum won the first Isle of Man Tourist Trophy race, in England in 1907, covering a total distance of about 255 km in ten laps.
-  German Formula One driver Michael Schumacher notched up an almost unimaginable 91 Grand Prix victories and seven World Championships, almost all of them with Ferrari.
-  Ayrton Senna won 41 Formula One Grand Prix, was world champion three times, and set the fastest qualifying time in 65 of the 161 Grand Prix that he raced.

-  Qatar's Nasser Al Attiyah won the Middle East Rally Championship 11 times between 2003 and 2011 and in 2011 he became the first Arab to win the famously dangerous Dakar Rally, which he has won twice more since then.
-  The home of motor racing in Qatar is the Losail International Circuit which opened in 2004 and staged the country's first Moto Grand Prix the same year.
-  The vintage motor racing car at the exit of the Qatar Olympic and Sports Museum, the Scuderia Ferrari Alfa Romeo 'Testa Fissa', was driven by a woman - Anna Maria 'La Marocchina' Peduzzi, the first woman to join the Ferrari team.
